## Ring Size Guide

Welcome to our Ring Size Guide. We hope this guide helps you determine the size that fits you best.

## 1. I have a Franck Muller ring.

At Franck Muller, the ring sizes are consistent across all of our collections. Therefore, you should use the same size as your current Franck Muller ring. If you do not remember your ring size, this information can be found on the Franck Muller Jewelry certificate.

## 2. I have a ring from another brand.

If you have a ring from another brand and you know its size, we suggest choosing the same size for your Franck Muller ring.

## 3. I don't have a ring and I don't know my size.

If you do not know your size, we kindly suggest you go visit one of our Boutiques and our team will gladly assist you. Otherwise, you may follow the instructions below :

- Wrap a ribbon or a string around the base of your finger.
- Mark the point on the ribbon or string where the ends meet.
- With a ruler, measure the ribbon or the string in millimeters.
- According to your measurements, identify your ring size on the International Ring Size Chart below.


## Examples :

- If your finger circumference measures $55,2 \mathrm{~mm}$, we advise you to choose the closest size (55).
- If your finger circumference measures $55,5 \mathrm{~mm}$, we advise you to choose the half size (if available) or the bigger size (56).
- If your finger circumference measures $55,8 \mathrm{~mm}$, we advise you to choose the closest size (56).

## 4. I have a ring but I don't know its size.

Start by taking an existing ring that fits your finger well. Then, position it over the circles below to determine the diameter that corresponds to your ring size. The circle should fit the inside of the ring from edge to edge. If you hesitate between two sizes, we kindly suggest you to choose the bigger one.


This Ring Size Guide will only be accurate if printed on a A4 size page. In order to make sure the guide has been printed correctly, we kindly suggest you to use a ruler and measure the lines below. The first line should measure 5 cm . The second line should measure 3 inches.


Please note, PDF documents tend to be automatically adjusted when printed which may result in wrong scales. Prior to doing so, we recommend checking your print settings and choosing a scale of $100 \%$.
